BOYS REC BASKETBALL, Winter 2017-2018

Welcome to another year of Boys Rec Basketball. Boys of Clifton Park have been enjoying this program for over 20 years, going back to its roots in the CYO basketball program. We stress recreation, instruction, and fun. There are no tryouts for Rec Basketball - every boy is placed on a team.

The program is open to all boys, from grades 2 through 12, who live within the Shenendehowa School District (whether they actually attend Shen schools or not). The only boys who are **not eligible** to participate are those who play on any Grades 8 & Under **Travel** basketball teams. Some **1st graders** are accepted each year as well, as long as they are able to compete in a division with 2nd and 3rd graders.

The program is conducted on Saturdays, from November 4 through late March. All sessions last 1.5 hours, with the 1st ½ hour (or more for grades 2-5) devoted to practice and the remaining hour devoted to actual game time. Players are rotated in and out of the actual game every 10 minutes, so that no one sits for very long. While we do not keep track of an official score (or team standings) for most of the season, we do conduct our annual "March Madness" play-off's, over the course of 4 weeks, to determine 1st and 2nd place champions in each division.

During the 1st session on November 4, the boys will be given an overview of the program and playing rules, divided up into their respective teams and then issued their game schedules for the rest of the season (Grades 10-12 schedules will be issued 1 week later). Because this is when teams are formed, it is very important that every boy in the program attends this 1st session. Each division will meet on that Saturday at the school at which they will be playing each Saturday of the season (although Grades 8-9 will also play at Shatekon and Koda).

Boys should report, on November 4, at the times listed below. *PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. Spaces are limited and are filled on a 1st-come, 1st-served basis.*

The 1st day schedule for each division, *for November 4 only*, is:

Grades 2-3	8:00 AM to 9:00 AM	Okte Elementary School
Grades 4-5	10:00 AM to 11:00 AM	Skano Elementary School
Grades 6-7	12:00 PM to 1:00 PM	Chango Elementary School
Grades 8-9	2:00 PM to 3:00 PM	Shen. High School West
Grades 10-12	4:00 PM to 5:30 PM	Shen. High School West

(**Grades 10-12 only** will also meet at the same time as above on **November 11**, when those teams are selected).

Saturday starting times (excluding March play-offs) *after November 4*:

Grades 2-3: anywhere from 8:00 to 5:00 (rotating schedule), Okte Elementary School
Grades 4-5: anywhere from 8:00 to 5:00 (rotating schedule), Skano Elementary School
Grades 6-7: anywhere from 8:00 to 5:00 (rotating schedule), Chango Elementary School
Grades 8-9: anywhere from 12:00 to 8:30 (rotating), Shatekon, Koda or High School West
Grades 10-12: anywhere from 10:30 to 7:30 (rotating schedule), High School West

The scope of this agreement extends to any actions taken by the Town of Clifton Park Office of Parks, Recreation & Community Affairs, the Town of Clifton Park, its employees, personnel, volunteers, and the instructor of any class or activity in responding to any emergency and/or medical situation or event.

I further agree that if my child does suffer any injury the Town of Clifton Park's Parks, Recreation and Community Affairs, through its employees or agents, has my permission to sign whatever consent forms required for any necessary emergency medical treatment. I further understand that the Town of Clifton Park will first attempt to contact me at the numbers listed above to obtain my consent for any such treatment.

I understand that all refund requests must be in writing and received 10 days prior to start of program and that there will be NO refunds after this time. Further, I acknowledge that there will be a \$10 non-refundable charge on all registrations.

Participants may be photographed while participating in a Clifton Park Parks & Recreation program and said photographs may be used to publicize activities as the Town deems appropriate.
