- 1) CSC Climate Action Plan – provided Zabed with the draft resolution to pursue developing a Climate Action Plan to address GHG Inventory/CAP for the Town Govt. approval. Zabed will modify the resolution for the July 7th Town Board (TB) meeting.
 - a. Joanne will coordinate the town’s electrical data working with CDRPC to collect data on the electrical usage and gas usage of the 5 main buildings that the town owns. Gerald Danielski, Diana Leis Delker and Diane Betzwieser said they would help.
- 2) Committee reports - At the town board meetings some of the committees report on what they have been doing. Zabed discussed the GREEN Committee providing him with updates, information, and highlights for upcoming TB meetings. (e.g., events, GREEN educational information, etc.)
 - a. Upcoming TB meeting on 7/6/26, Zabed will present the Climate Action Plan (CAP) resolution, announce the Repair Café, and have 2 GREEN members discuss the importance of the CAP.
- 3) Repair Cafe – (Cathy) Cathy Fruhauf discussed how she was all set with coaches for the RC at the Clifton Park Senior Center on July 11. Fliers were provided to the group and people signed up for where they would post the fliers in person and online. Set up will be on Friday before the event (time TBD). She is still in need of baked goods and registration people.
- 4) Plastic Free July – (Cathy) discussed this topic and posting information on social media (Town FB) ask the library to post something.
- 5) July 4th Parade - (Joanne) discussed the GREEN Committee and the Tribe marching in the July 4th parade; driving a red, white, and blue Tesla. Handouts include solar tattoos, coloring books, and some music from her car. If anyone is interested in walking with the group, they should contact Joanne.
- 6) TS Food Scraps Composting update – Nancy and volunteers will be sifting the FS compost on June 22 at the TS. Compost will be made available for the composters.

- 8) Plastic Detox – (Diana) Tabled discussion until next meeting.
- 9) Sustainable Lawns Say No to Pesticides – (Kathy) discussed pesticide education and forming a small group to work on this. More details and work to come.
- 10) Solar Moratorium – we discussed the 6-month Tier 2 and 3 Solare Panel Moratorium signed on May 19th with regard to who has the lead on this and what actions are being taken. We discussed requesting this info at the 7/6/26 TB meeting.
