PUBLIC HEARING, 7:10 PM
TO CONSIDER A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1995
THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE TOWN OF CLIFTON PARK

The Town Clerk read the Notice of Public Hearing as published in The Daily Gazette on September 11, 2006.

Supervisor Barrett explained this review is done every two years and over the past few years the emphasis has been on open space preservation and proactive land use planning activities.

Director of Planning Maynard reported the document has been available on the website and in the Town Clerk's office.

Councilman Speckhard explained the Comprehensive Plan is not mandatory legislation, however, it is legislation and thus puts a very strong legal controlling impact on other legislation to reflect the basic goals and values of the Plan.

The public hearing was opened for comments from the audience at 7:20 p.m.

Everyone was given an opportunity to speak in favor of or against the proposed local law and no one wished to be heard. Supervisor Barrett declared the public hearing closed at 7:21 p.m.

PRESENTATIONS TO THE BOARD

WHEREAS, the Town of Clifton Park has agreed to allow the Towns of Malta and Halfmoon residents to participate in the Town of Clifton Park household hazardous waste collection program with the Towns of Malta and Halfmoon being responsible for their

fair share of the program's net cost; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Clifton Park does hereby authorize the Towns of Malta and Halfmoon and the Town of Clifton Park to enter into a municipal cooperation agreement relating to the collection and disposal of household hazardous waste based upon the following understanding:

- Town of Clifton Park will be responsible for the proper administration of the program and will be responsible for the registration process.
- Towns of Malta and Halfmoon will reimburse the Town of Clifton Park its fair share of the net cost based upon the number of Malta and Halfmoon residents participating to the total participants.
- In addition to the hazardous waste disposal costs, the Towns of Malta and Halfmoon agree to pay a \$16 administration fee per registered participants to be paid to the Town of Clifton Park.
- Town of Clifton Park will set aside approximately forty "slots" for Town of Malta residents.
- Town of Clifton Park will set aside approximately sixty "slots" for Town of Halfmoon residents.

WHEREAS, a study of the four way intersection of Main Street with Hatlee Road has been conducted by McDonald Engineering, and WHEREAS, McDonald Engineering has recommended installing stop signs at the intersection of Main Street and Hatlee Road, and WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent agrees with McDonald Engineering's recommendation; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized to install a stop sign on Main Street on the northbound approach and one sign on Hatlee Road on the southbound approach to the intersection of Main Street and Hatlee Road in Jonesville. Superintendent of Highways Kukuk explained patterns have changed and with the town taking over ownership of Longkill Road, the town now controls three of the four approaches to the intersection. McDonald Engineering studied the intersection and recommends a four-way stop. Saratoga County Commissioner of Public Works Ritchey is in agreement. The Town Board asked that notices go up on Main Street and Hubbs Road advising motorists of the new stop signs. Supervisor Barrett recommended using an electronic board for public notification. Councilman Roth said the stop signs will give motorists the opportunity to keep to the 30 mile per hour speed limit on Main Street.
